Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 4pm by Supervisor James Nelson

The board members in attendance were: Supervisor James Nelson, Treasurer Loreena King, Clerk Julie Norton, and Trustee Gloria Hansen, Trustee Debra Huebner

Supervisor:

1. Supervisor Nelson reports the ARPA fund has been officially closed out.
2. Supervisor reports troubles with being billed and not getting to service promised for free from Highline. Has been resolved and appears to be billing correctly now.
3. The budget meeting will be held on Tuesday March 24th. At Doyle twp at 4pm. Notice has been placed in the paper.
4. More discussion about the new cameras and where they will be placed outside. Facing the ball diamond and the upcoming new playground in the spring.
5. Board of Review went well. Only 3 people attending to issue complaints or questions.

Minutes and Bills:

1. A motion was made by Trustee Huebner to accept the last month's minutes and pay the bills as presented for this month. Supported by treasurer King. Motion carried.

Clerks Reports:

1. Reports for the General account was discussed by Clerk Norton. A motion to accept the report made by Clerk Norton was made by Trustee Hansen
Supported by Trustee Hansen Motion carried.

Treasurers Report:

1. Reports for the General account a were presented by King. A motion was made by Clerk Norton to accept the report. Supported by Trustee Huebner. Motion carried.

Assessor's Report: Assessor Nathan Olsen was not present.

Hall Rentals: report given by Trustee Huebner.

Schoolcraft County Road Commission:

Ian Stampfly was present. He presented 2 bids for the Corbridge road. One from Bacco for \$135,945.00. And a bid from Payne & Dolan for \$176,359.00. A motion was made by Clerk Norton to accept the lower bid from Bacco. Support was given by Treasurer King. Motion carried.

Schoolcraft County Commissioner.

He was not available.

Fire Chief's Report:

1. Chief Nelson reports 7 runs in February. 5 medical, 1 structure fire, and 1 car accident.
2. Pipeline safety training will be April 1st. Several fire dept members will attend.
3. Inwood township has made a donation of medical equipment to Doyle township. As they no longer intend to have an ambulance system in their township. We thank Inwood Township very much.
4. The portable tank for water drops was ordered by the fire chief. This new tank will hold 2100 gallons and will have an extra 500 gallon bladder if needed for bigger fires. Some of the new fire tankers hold 3000 gallons and they are having to wait around before dumping their whole load. This will make things run more smoothly and be able to put more water
5. Also ordered 4 face shield to replace broken gear.
6. Accountability tags are being ordered. This is an item our insurance wanted the township to carry. The rest of the county intends on using these also. This is to keep track of who is in a structure during an emergency situation.

New Business:

EGLE permit was authorized on February 27th 2026 by the Michigan Department Environment, Great lakes and Energy (EGLE) Water resources Division. Site Name : 77-Trail 2 Bear Ck Swamp relocation- Doyle/Mueller Twp. Permit-tee: Schoolcraft Motorized Trail Association. David Grabski.

Old Business:

1. Floor and wall repair to the hall will be bid out for the Doyle Twp hall. Floor is being pushed up from frost. And walls are brittle and break easily.
